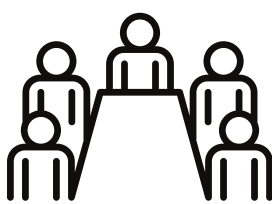

Search Timeline



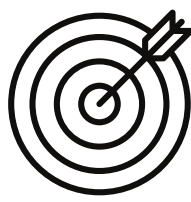

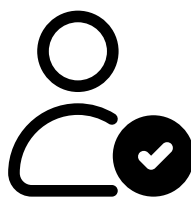
